### How does NAPLAN assess students?

NAPLAN assesses students in literacy and numeracy skills. The assessment is designed to measure the skills and knowledge that all Australian children should have at the end of Year 5.

The assessment is conducted in a computer-based format, which allows students to interact with the questions and receive immediate feedback.

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## Reading the NAPLAN report

The NAPLAN report shows a proficiency scale for each assessment area (numeracy, reading, writing, spelling and grammar and punctuation) with a student's result
